Canterbury (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel

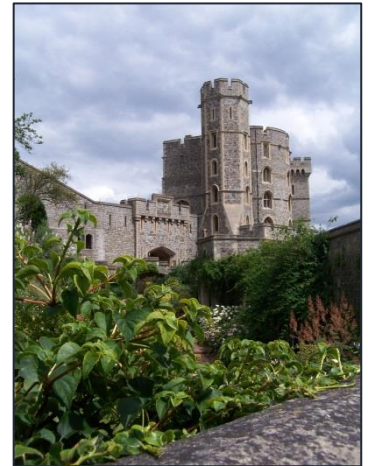

Visit the 6th-century ruins of St. Augustine's Abbey and walk through Christ Church Gate, and visit Canterbury Cathedral

Evening dinner and overnight



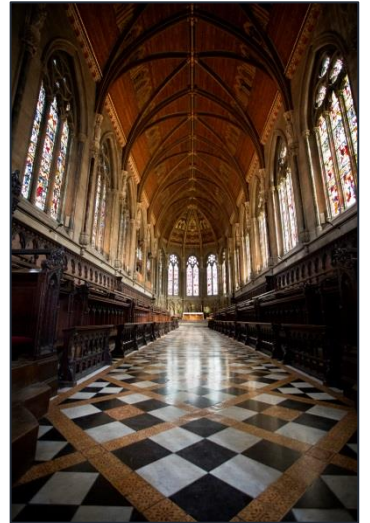
Day 6 **London / Cambridge** **(B,D)**

Transfer to the East coast of England stopping en route in Cambridge. Enjoy a tour of King's College and its Chapel, two of the most recognizable buildings in the city

Continue to Ely where we will take a guided tour of the stunning 11th-century building with its world-renown Lady Chapel

Evening dinner and overnight



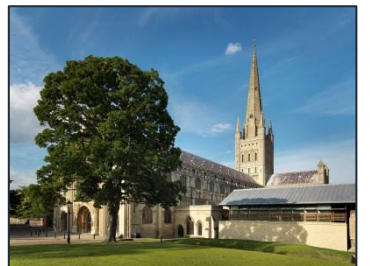
Day 8 **Walsingham** **(B,D)**
